

# Lesson Plan

**Subject: English Literacy**

**Grade level: 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade**

**Time Limit: 30 Minutes**

**Lesson Title: Fix It!**

<b>Standard, Benchmark, Indicator</b>	CCSS.ELA-LITERACY.L.2.2.A: Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English capitalization, punctuation - Capitalize holidays, product names, and geographic names
<b>Lesson Goal</b>	Student's being able to know when there should be a capital letter and how to fix a sentence without proper capitalization.
<b>Lesson Objective</b>	Students will be able to analyze a sentence and identify what should be capitalized and apply proper punctuation.
<b>Essential Question(s)</b>	What do we capitalize? Why do we capitalize? Where does punctuation go?
<b>Assessment and Criteria</b>	EdPuzzle and Capital Letters Worksheet
<b>Resources (books, articles, video links, etc.)</b>	Edpuzzle video/app, worksheet, common core standards, blooms taxonomy action verbs, biglearners.com

	<b>Est. Time of Task</b>	<b>Lesson Activities</b>
<b>Beginning</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Teacher will use remind students about last class period and our two new words "capitalization"</li> <li>-Teacher will use anchor chart to remind class the three things we capitalize (holidays, product names, and geographic/people names) and then ask why?</li> <li>-Teacher will remind students that we capitalize things at the beginning of sentence because it is a clue to us where the sentence starts and because anything that starts a sentence is important.</li> <li>-We also capitalize things that are important so names of things and places</li> </ul>

<b>Middle</b>		<p>Students will view EdPuzzle and assess throughout the short videos</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Teacher will do a practice fix it sentence</li> <li>-Teacher will ask for help on second sentence</li> </ul>
<b>End</b>		<p>-Each student will receive their own worksheet of capital letters that they will complete</p> <p>Wrap up questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Okay so class what are the things we capitalize?</li> <li>-Why do we capitalize things?</li> <li>-What clues do capital words give us?</li> </ul>
